Compañía Minera Autlán, S.A.B. of C.V. (Autlán) reports that yesterday the Ministry of Economy published in the Official Journal of the Federation the preliminary ruling on the anti-dumping case of high carbon ferromanganese (HC FeMn) originating in the Republic of Korea, determining a provisional compensatory quota of 35.64 % to all imports of HC FeMn originating in the Republic of Korea regardless of the country of origin.

This decision comes from the anti-dumping investigation initiated on January 8 of this year in response to the request filed by Autlán on November 20, 2015. The Ministry of Economy determined that there are sufficient elements to indicate that during the period under investigation the increase in Imports of HC FeMn from the Republic of Korea under conditions of price discrimination caused material damage to the performance of the Mexican industry.
